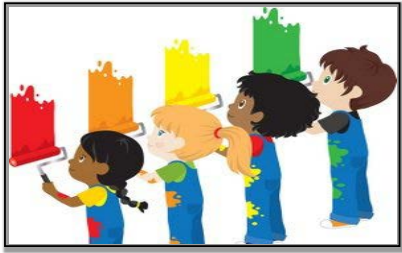


Let's Paint The Town!
